Computers for Success Nunavut (CFSN) is a not-for-profit program dedicated to reducing e-waste and making computers available to Nunavummiut or Nunavut-based organisations in need. We are able to provide these computers at little to no cost by refurbishing donated hardware. CFSN has distributed more than 1,000 computers to users in Nunavut communities primarily through the te(a)ch program from the Pinnguaq Association. Learn more at cfsn.ca.

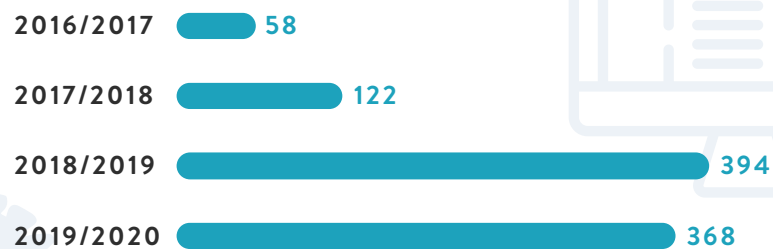
The Future

As our educational initiatives continue, the need for hardware will only increase. CFSN has been heavily reliant on computers donated from the South, but we are now looking to form partnerships with Northern organizations to begin transitioning to a fully self-sufficient Nunavut operation. Over the next six months, we will be establishing a refurbishment model that will be honed in Iqaluit and then replicated in other communities across the territory.
